



Drs. Wani Wall Mihich Postdoctoral Scholarship

Area of Study

Candidates who are selected as Drs. Wani Wall Mihich Postdoctoral Scholars will have opportunities to work on novel anticancer drug development and mechanism of action studies.

Qualification of the Candidates

Applicants should be talented, dedicated and well-trained individuals, having held their PhD degree or equivalent for 10 years or less. The candidate should also be highly energetic with interest and significant training in the study of experimental drug mechanisms of action and targeted molecular cancer therapeutics.

Compensation and Program Terms

The initial year compensation will be from \$40,000 to \$55,000 based on the overall qualification and previous experience of a candidate. Compensation adjustment from the second year will depend on the previous year performance. The program term is for 3 years and can be extended, which will depend on performance.

Documents that Need to Be Provided by Applicants

Favorable applicants need to read relevant publications collected on the Canget website under the "Publication & News" section. The applicants are required to write some succinct research thoughts related to the potential follow-up studies to demonstrate the applicants' wisdom for consideration. Competitive applicants will have freedom to explore his/her own ideas under the team leader's supervision.

Applicants also need to provide his/her updated resume or CV with information of at least three references for contacting.

To Whom Should the Applicants Send Their Documents

Applicants should send the required documents to Dr. Fengzhi Li (fengzhi.li@roswellpark.org). Successful candidate will have the title of **Drs. Wani Wall Mihich Postdoctoral Scholar** for doing research work in the Department of Pharmacology and Therapeutic, Roswell Park Cancer Institute (Buffalo, New York). The research work will be under supervision from Dr. Fengzhi Li.

Of note, recruitment of Drs. Wani Wall Mihich Postdoctoral Scholars is an activity throughout the year without deadline.
